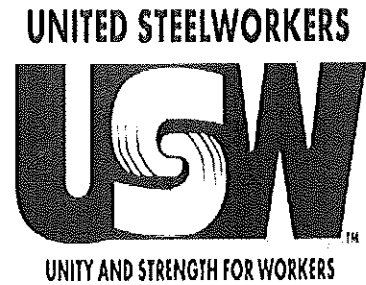


June 2012

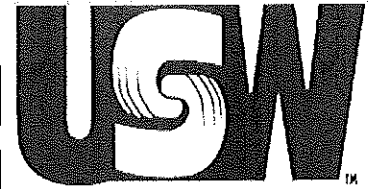

Article XI Section 2. page 15 Tool Allowance
 On the first pay period of each contract year for the term of this Agreement, the Company will pay each employee in the Maintenance Classification up to three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00) for tool allowance. Employees shall purchase tools that carry a lifetime guarantee. If the tool is not offered with a lifetime guarantee an industrial grade tool shall be purchased. Receipts will be required for all tool allowance reimbursements excluding the first year of this contract. Only those tools identified in the Company Minimum Required Tool List will be replaced. Employees that have been in continuous service for more than one year of hire date will be entitled to the tool allowance.

Article VI Section 11 page 31

Any employee (excluding a probationary employee who has been on the active payroll for less than thirty days) who is required to serve on a municipal, county or federal jury, or grand jury, shall be paid the difference between the amount paid for such service and his Basic Wage Rate unless the Fixed Payment Rate as defined in the Wage Agreement applies, for the time lost from his regularly scheduled work shift by reason of such service.
